Livonia Soccer Club – Laws of the Game 2019

GAME TIME IS 25 MINUTES

SUBSTITUTIONS are unlimited and may be made on the fly from the designated bench area. Players leaving the field must be near the bench, and not interfering with play during the switch. Violation of this rule (too many players on the field) will result in a free kick for the opponents. The second infraction by the same team in one game will result in a yellow card being issued to the offending player.

GOALKEEPER SUBSTITUTIONS must be made during stoppage of play and with the official's permission.

ALL PLAYERS (INCLUDING GOALKEEPER) MUST WEAR SHIN GUARDS on the field of play, with socks over shin guards.

THE KICK-OFF to begin the game, or to restart play after a goal is scored, may go in any direction but cannot be a direct kick on goal.

BALL IN AND OUT OF PLAY- the ball will be considered in play unless: (1) the ball strikes the ceiling, after which the ball would be put back into play with an indirect free kick from the point on the centerline closest to the spot where it hit the ceiling. (2) The ball goes over the net along the sideline or over the top of the bleachers, after which the ball would be put back into play with an indirect free kick at a spot closest to where it went out. (3) the ball lands on the top of the goal or behind the goal net after which the ball would be put back into play with a goal kick or corner kick. (4) At the discretion of the referee the ball becomes unplayable, after which it would be put back into play with a drop ball or indirect free kick. (5) The ball hits above the goals, in a predetermined area by the tournament officials to be out of play, the ball will be put back into play with either a goal kick or a corner kick.

OFFSIDES - This law will not be enforced during the tournament.

TIME PENALTIES

- *Yellow Card*- any foul which results in the issuance of a yellow card to the offending player will require the player to leave the game for a full three minutes. Her/his team must play short a player during the time span unless the opponent scores.
- *Red Card*- any foul which results in the issuance of a red card to the offending player will result in the player's ejection from the game and from the following game as well. Her/his team must play short a player for a full five minutes regardless of whether the opponent scores.

GOALKEEPER RESTRICTIONS

Possession - a ball passed back from the feet of any teammate may not be picked up by the keeper.

Centerline - the keeper may not propel the ball over the centerline in the air without hitting the walls, net, floor or any player first. However, he may play a long pass with his feet as a field player.

Punting- the keeper may not punt or drop kick the ball.

Receiving the Ball - picking up the ball with 1 or both feet out of the box will result in an indirect kick.

FREE KICKS

A second whistle will not be used unless there is a substitution, or unless 5 yards is asked for. A team has five seconds to put the ball into play after it has been put into position and defenders are 3 yards away.

All free kicks are indirect.

Defensive players must be at least 3 yards from the ball on all free kicks.

SLIDE TACKLES - There will be no sliding allowed by any player.

POINTS SYSTEM:

3 points – Win

1 point – Tie

1 Point per goal, maximum 3 per game

1/2 Point for SHUTOUT

TIE BREAKERS FOR PLAYOFF SEATING

1) Head to Head

2) Most Wins

3) Goal Difference up to 3 per game

4) Goals Scored up to 3 per game

5) Sudden Death

In the case of a tie in a playoff or final game, one player will be removed from the field after each minute of play until there is 1 player left for each team. The first team to score a goal will be declared the winner.

Equipment Requirements:

All players must wear shin guards and they must be covered with socks. Games are played on gym floor therefore sneakers or indoor shoes must be worn (NO TURF SHOES or CLEATS ALLOWED). Goalie helmets are optional. All teams should bring two different colored jerseys to avoid color conflicts.
