- I. Jason Tonkery called meeting to order at 7:00p. Roll call was done verbally.
 - February 2021 board meeting minutes were emailed to board members and reviewed prior to this meeting. Minutes were approved via email.

II. **Committee Updates**

RDYSL Committee/Uniform Update

- Jason will schedule a coach meeting to cover COVID guidelines & RDYSL rule changes/updates.
- May need to keep a log of spectators for home games, provide spectator passes, or table check in to enforce 2 spectator per player rule.
- Consider each team to have a manager to handle COVID protocols.
- Field Coordinator (Brad) will be emailing coaches to resolve internal game conflicts.
 - 11 games scheduled at Myers Field
 - Uniform deadline 3/8/21. Brad will place order with Vic (new jerseys & last year replacements) and invoice parents through teamsnap.
- Consider masks for our games/players even though not a RDYSL rule.
- Dan confirmed RDYSL would not allow anymore than 22 per roster.
- Need to reaffirm zero tolerance at games, no comments to refs.

Facilities Committee Update

- Not using field 3 this year due to no teams under U11, can use for practices.
- No lighted games this summer.
- Jason will reach out to Rob Wood at Finger Lakes Law & Maint. to renew moving contract.

- Jason has meeting scheduled next week with Willow regarding lease renewal, attempting to proactively renew, update at next board meeting.
 - Supposed to have utilities transferred over to club before end of current lease in 2022.
 - Scott talked with O'Connell Electric about the switchover and they suggested they be part of the conversation with National Grid to ensure recreational use versus commercial use to avoid higher electric costs.
 - Dan mentioned there may be some stuff in storage at clubhouse previously purchased for replacing lighting at field.

Summer Req Committee Update

- Cost to club to run program is \$10/kid insurance and \$20 for shirt/ball.
- No change in cost for 2021 summer program, remain at \$50 per player.
- Next steps; update flyer, approval from school, printed from Pennysaver, order yard signs., schedule picture day.
- Move forward as if school will approve use of field.
- Field 3 and pit fields at Willow as a backup if need be.
- Angela will schedule another committee meeting.

Winter Skills/Drills Update

- Jason will send an email to coaches asking them to drop funds collected for winter practices at the Sportsgarden to him once coach has all funds for the team. (one drop off per team)
- Dan will send an email to gage interest in U16 team practices, maybe add another hour (to sportsgarden) for the U16
- Adjust schedule to account for Easter Sunday, start March 20th.
- Historically girls U18 and boys U11 have not had great practice turnouts.

III. Misc. Topics

- Live-streaming, watch noise around camera if recording. Video quality and lack of zoom makes live stream difficult but allows family and friends to watch.
